Eligibility

Individuals who are currently employed by high schools, postsecondary institutions, career centers, area career and technical schools, etc. Contributions and achievements on which the nomination is based should have been made within the past ten years. The nominee must be a paid professional member of SkillsUSA for the last five years.

Nevada Association of SkillsUSA Advisor of the Year Nomination Form Nominator Special Instructions

Nominator should submit the following:

- A maximum of three letters of support or recommendation
- A color portrait (head and shoulders) photograph of the nominee
- The state director will submit a letter of support to the applicant that qualifies for the National Advisor of the Year Award

A selection committee will review all applications and select the Nevada Advisor of the Year.

The procedure for the national award selection process is as follows:

- (1) The due date for submitting an application for a state advisor of the year to the national selection process is December 1st. Therefore, the advisor of the year in Nevada for the 2019-2020 program year will be the state submittal for the following year for the national advisor of the year;
- (2) After all nominations from the states are received they are separated by regions;
- (3) The applications are then forwarded to the regional representative from a different region (i.e., region 1 applications are forwarded to the region 5 representative);
- (4) The regional representative forms a review committee to select a regional winner;
- (5) Applications for the regional winners are sent back to the national chair;
- (6) The regional winners are interviewed at the NLSC in Kansas City and an overall national winner is selected.
