FY' 21 OPERATION BUDGET REPORT REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATUS

Sindie Read said our numbers show a surplus because of the decision to go virtual. We've only spent \$61,740.25 out of our \$228,611 budget. The state allocated additional funds to the organization. The Nevada Department of Education requested that the organization encumber the funds as quickly as possible during the year.

REVIEW OF STATE CONFERENCE

Sindie Read said the state conference had about 550 members participate, which is down from the normal 1,500. Many businesses and industries helped to host the events. There were 71 students who continued to Nationals. The conference went as well as it could have gone. There were no grievances or complaints. All contests ran virtually or test-based.

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REVIEW OF NATIONAL CONFERENCE

There were 71 students that competed at nationals. The event was nice, but it was quite a bit of work. Sindie Read would like to thank the teachers and advisors for their continued diligence toward helping our members succeed. Many were Zoom contests. Since Nevada used "The Hub," the national organization's national learning management system, we did better off the start because we were prepared.

OTHER BUSINESS

Sindie Read wanted to let the Board know that Nationals will be held in Atlanta, Georgia June 20-24, 2022. We will have buses to go to and from Atlanta Hartsfield Jackson Airport. Once students are downtown, all events are within walking distance. Sindie will have more information during the next meeting after attending the National State Adviser Meeting.

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Matt Mayhood suggested that we start thinking about the Nevada Department of Education's shift to two-year programs and combining of programs. Tim Conley is concerned about being audited by the National Office. Sindie Read says that Nationals allows students to continue to compete if a student has exhausted all available courses in their program of study.

Two-year programs are now just being written. The 22-23 school year is the earliest year that the courses will change except for Auto which has already changed. There will be complementary courses that will allow a student to continue.

Dr. Dana Ryan says that we need to discuss dual-credit courses and if they are being taught as a secondary or postsecondary programs.

Dr. Dana Ryan asked about college credit. Denise Burton says she's not on the committee, but there are concerns about the lack of an exit test for two-year programs.

Scott Holcomb asked about enrollment. Sindie Read said that if a student is still in high school, regardless of postsecondary enrollment, they are still in secondary.
