YEAR-TO-DATE FINANCIAL REPORT

Sindie Read presented the financial report. Fall Leadership is occurring as two events. One event in the north and one event in the south. The organization has spent money on officer leadership.

FALL LEADERSHIP

There are two events for Leadership. In the North, the event will be at Circus Circus Reno on November 11. In the South, the event will be at Sunset Station on November 18. Attendance is just about at the same amount as when we held the event in Elko. There are 75 participants in the North and 160 participants in the South. Tristan Hays from Clark County School District will send out another email to lock in participants to determine transportation.

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REGIONALS STATE CONFERENCE

Tristan Hays says that there will probably not be many welding competitors this year. Sindie Read says that Photography has been merging into new pathways. Read is going to reach out to College of Southern Nevada to determine if they can hold a Photography Contest. Considering the new program of study for Multimedia Communications, we will need to determine which contests apply to the course. The North is confident that we will need a Welding Fabrication Regional contest.

Regional Contests will be February 5, 2022.

The State Conference is Monday, April 4, 2022 - Thursday, April 7, 2022. The social will be bowling.

Sindie Read says that there will be an in-person State Leadership and Skills Conference. Read has requested to know how many students are planning to attend, which will determine if a Regional Conference is necessary.

NEW STATE CONTESTS

There have been two requests for addition to the State Leadership and Skills Conference. One event is Criminal Justice and the other is Cybersecurity. Denise Burton reported that Randi Hunewell is happy to host the Criminal Justice Contest if added. There are six Criminal Justice programs and one Law Enforcement program in the state. There are 28 schools that offer Cybersecurity.

The Nevada Department of Education submitted a request to add Criminal Justice.

Rose Coe from Advanced Technical Academy submitted a request to add Cybersecurity.

Nevada will be housed at the Hilton Atlanta. Bussing will not be provided between the hotel and the Georgia World Congress Center, where events are being held. The Peachtree Center has several dining options for students. However, being in the downtown area, prices are high. Students will be warned to leave one hour before events to compensate for walking between venues. Parking is \$42 per day at Hilton Atlanta.
