Students will be tested in the following areas:

Oxygen Fuel Cutting

- Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW)
- Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW)

Required projects will be taken from the AWS Entry Level Welder Series

Contestants will also be required to take a written test covering general welding knowledge.

Contestants must bring the following items:

• Hearing protection

• Leathers and welding gloves

- Soap stone with holder
- 10-inch vise grips
- Combination Square
- Divider or Compass
- Ball Peen Hammer (small)
- Tool Box or Tool Bucket

- Safety glasses with side shields
- No. 2 pencil and pen
- Steel tape measure
- Carbon steel wire brush
- Chipping hammer w/ or w/o wire brush
- Center Punch
- Scribe
- Welding helmet/face shield/goggles with appropriate #5 and #10 filer plates or lens

**Note:** Contestants must wear appropriate work shoes and work clothes. Safety glasses w/side shields must be worn under the welding hood and/or cutting goggles. (NO TENNIS SHOES)
