- Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW)

Required projects will be based on competencies from the AWS Entry Level Sense Program.

Contestants will also be required to take a written test covering general welding knowledge.

Contestants must bring the following items:

Note: Contestants must wear appropriate work shoes and work clothes. Safety glasses w/side shields must be worn under the welding hood and/or cutting goggles. (NO TENNIS SHOES)

Due to time limitations, the Interview portion of the contest will not be given. No Resume is required as well.
